NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (i) to (viii) of subsection 5 and clause (1) to (9) of sub-section 6 of section 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 (10 of 1955) read with the notification No GSR. 630 (E) dated 31/8/2001 issued by the Govt. of India, Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution, and with the prior concurrence of the Central Government, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh hereby makes the following order namely:

1. Short title, extent and commencement : -

- 1) This order may be called the Arunachal Pradesh Declaration of Stock and Prices and Monitoring of Essential Commodities Order, 2005.
- 2) It extends to the whole of Arunachal Pradesh.
- 3) It shall come into force from the date of its publication in the Gazette.

2. Definition: - In this order, unless the context otherwise requires:-

- (a) 'Dealer' means any person carrying on the business of selling of essential commodity and includes a producer, and any importer or wholesaler or a retailer, and also a broker, or commission agent, distributor or any other agent of a producer or wholesaler having authority to sell any essential commodity belonging to his principal.
- (b) 'Essential Commodity' means any of the commodities mentioned in schedule I to this order, or such other essential commodities, as may be notified by the Government under this order from time to time.
- (c) 'Form' means a form set forth in schedule II to this order.
- (d) 'Importer' means any person who brings any essential commodity into the State for the purpose of sale in the State.
- (e) 'Place of business' means a place where the books or accounts of a dealer's business are kept and where orders or offers involving purchases or sale of any essential commodity are received and includes place or places where the dealers store any essential commodity.
- (f) 'Producer' means a person engaged in the production, manufacture or processing of any essential commodity and includes a person who uses any essential commodity for production, manufactures or processing of any other commodity not being an essential commodity, but does not include a producer or consumer.

- (g) 'Retailers' means a person who sells any essential commodity to a consumer.
- (h) 'Wholesaler' means a person who sells any essential commodity to any other dealer or to retailer.
- (i) 'Government' means the State Government of Arunachal Pradesh.
- (j) 'Deputy Commissioner' means the Deputy Commissioner, of concerned District.
- (k) 'Director' means Director of Civil Supplies, Arunachal Pradesh.

3. Display of stock and price lists:

- An officer not below the rank of District Supply Officer of concerned District or any other officer specially empowered in this behalf by the State Government or Deputy Commissioner of concerned district may require: -
 - (a) Every dealer to display the list of BPL and Antyodaya beneficiaries conspicuously at a place as near to the entrance of his place of business in Form II(a).
 - (b) Every dealer to display conspicuously at a place as near to the entrance of his place of business as possible the entitlement of essential commodities, scale of issue, retail issue price, timings of opening and closing of the fair price shop in Form II(b) on each day.
 - (c) Every dealer to display conspicuously at a place as near to the entrance of this place of business as possible the stock of essential commodities received during the month and closing stock of essential commodities and authority for redressal of any grievances/lodging complaints with respect to quality of essential commodities under the PDS in Form II(c).
- 2. No dealer shall withhold from sale of any essential commodity held in stock by him or charge from any customer a price not exceeding the price displayed under clause (b) of sub-paragraph (I) above.
- (i). Every licensee shall maintain record of ration card holders (APL, BPL and Antyodaya), stock register, issue or sale register.
- (ii). Every licensee shall sale essential commodities as per the entitlement of ration card holders at the retail issue prices fixed by the State Government.
- (iii). Every licensee shall furnish the copies of specified documents, namely, ration card register, stock register to the office of the Gram Panchayat or Nagar Palika or Vigilance Committee or any other body authorized by licensing authority.
- (iv). Every licensee shall display the samples of food grains being supplied through the fair price shop.

- (v). Every licensee shall produce books and records relating to the allotment and distribution of essential commodities to the inspecting agency and furnish such information as may be called for by the Licensing Authority.
- (vi). Every licensee shall furnish the actual distribution of essential commodities and the balance stock at the end of the month to the Licensing Authority with a copy to the Gram Panchayat.

4. Monitoring:

- 1. The Director/Deputy Commissioner in their respective jurisdiction shall ensure a proper system of Monitoring of FPS and Licensing Authority shall prescribe model sale register/stock register and ration card register.
- 2. The Director/Deputy Commissioner or any other officer of Civil Supply Department not below the rank of Sub-Inspector of Supply shall ensure that regular periodical inspection and surprise check of Fair Price Shop conducted as per prescribed schedule I.
- 3. The Deputy Commissioner shall ensure that the monthly vigilance committee meeting on PDS at District level/Block level/Circle level/FPS level are held on a regular basis. The date of such meeting shall be notified by the Deputy Commissioner.
- 4. The Director/Deputy Commissioner shall ensure a periodic system of reporting and the complete information in this regard shall be sent in the prescribed from as follows: -
- (i). Every licensee shall submit monthly report return in form 'A' (see clause 8) of Government of India's order No. GSR-630(E) of 31/8/01 to the District Authority by the 7th of the following month.
- (ii). The District Authorities shall submit to State Government by the 15th of the following month for which allocation is made in Form 'B' & form 'C' and utilization certification (see clause 8) of Government of India's order No. GSR-630(E) of 31/8/01.
- (iii). The State Government shall submit to the Central Government by the end of the following month for which allocation is made in Form 'C' and utilization certification (see clause 8) of Government of India's order No. GSR-630(E) of 31/8/01.
- 5. Deputy Commissioner shall ensure that future allocation of food grain to District shall be linked to the receipt of regular reports from the respective District and furnishing of utilization certificates by them within a period of two months from the month for which allocation is made.
- 6. Deputy Commissioner shall ensure monitoring of the functioning of the PDS at the Fair Price Shop level through the computer network of the NIC installed in the District NIC centers. For this purpose computerized codes shall be issued to each FPS in the district.

- 7. The Deputy Commissioner shall educate the ration card holders regarding their rights and privileges under the Public Distribution System during vigilance Committee meeting and by use of electronic and print media as well as display of boards outside Fair Price Shops.
- 8. The Deputy Commissioner shall ensure that implementation of citizens charters which were adopted by the State Government on the basis of model citizen charter issued by the Central Government communicated by the State Government vide No. DCS/MON-115/97 dated 19/2/98 which should be implemented strictly.

The Deputy Commissioner shall direct the concerned licensee to provide relevant extracts of the documents maintained by him on application made by a beneficiary, on payment of fee, prescribed by the Licensing Authority.

5. Power of entry, search, seizure etc: -

- (i). The Director Of Civil Supplies/DC, a police Officer not below the rank of Sub-Inspector of Police and Officers of Civil Supplies department not below the rank of Sub-Inspector Of Supply may with such assistance if any, as he think fit:
 - (a) Require the owner, occupier or any other person in charge of any place, premise, Vehicles or vessel in which he has reason to believe that any contravention of the provision of this order has been, is being or is about to be committed, to produce any books, accounts or other documents showing transaction relating to such contraventions:
 - (b) Enter, inspect or break open and search any place or premises, vehicle or vessel in which he has reason to believe that any contravention of the provisions of this order is being or is about to be committed;
 - (c) Of any books of accounts and documents which, in the opinion of such person, may be useful for, or relevant to, any proceeding under this rule and the person from whose custody such books of accounts or documents are seized shall be entitled to make copies thereof or to take extracts there from in the presence of and Officer having the custody of such books of accounts of documents;
 - (d) Search, seizure and remove stock of essential commodities and the animals, vehicles, vessels or other conveyance used in carrying the said essential commodity in contravention of the provisions of this order, take or authorize the taking of all measures necessary for securing the production of the stocks of essential commodity and the animals, vehicle or other conveyance seized in a court and for their safe custody pending such production.

- (ii). The provision of section 100 of the Code of Criminal procedure, 1971 relating to search and seizure, shall apply to search and seizure under this clause.
- **6.** <u>Sanction for prosecution</u>: No prosecution in respect of an alleged contravention of the provision of this order shall be instituted without the written sanction of the Deputy Commissioner of concerned district or Director.
- 7. Repeal and saving: From the date of commencement of this order the Arunachal Pradesh Declaration of Stocks and Prices, 1992 shall stand repealed.
